

Troop 139 Code of Conduct

As a Boy Scout and a member of troop 139, I agree to try to behave in a manner that is consistent with the Scout Law. By being part of the troop and in order to participate in troop activities I agree to the following:

- I will cooperate with whomever is leading the activity. This includes
 - Doing what is asked of me the first time it is asked
 - Listening to the leaders and not talking/being disruptive when the leaders are talking
- I will treat the youth leaders with the same respect that I treat the adult leaders
- I will wear the correct uniform (properly) for each meeting/activity
- I will respect the rights and feelings of all members of the troop including
 - I will leave other people's property alone
 - I will not be abusive to others, either verbally or physically
 - I will not make fun of others
 - I will do my best to be helpful to others in the troop
- I will treat troop equipment with care and leave it in the same (or better) condition than when I got it

Failure to meet the above level of conduct may result in any of the following: my being removed from the activity, a conference between the scoutmaster, scout, and parents, or being barred from further activities.

I also understand that if I feel that I'm being treated unfairly that I should speak to the scoutmaster or an assistant scoutmaster. If I feel that the adult leaders are treating me unfairly, I should ask the troop committee for help.
